







National Dialog Forum in Argentina Chemical Industry and climate change: challenges and opportunities

Climate change is one of the most pressing challenges of our time. Human influence is making extreme weather events, including heat waves, torrential rains, and droughts more frequent and severe. In this scenario, it is necessary to address this issue in order to generate short, medium and long-term commitments to take action.

The chemical and petrochemical industry play a key role in this, accounting for 8% of the global Greenhouse gas emissions, and 13% of the emissions from the industrial process sector in Argentina. Given this context, it is necessary to share and expand knowledge about the importance and impacts of climate change, in order to develop and propose overcoming alternatives that allow us to face the challenges and enhance the opportunities that this scenario poses to be better prepared for what is coming.

Based on this, the Chamber of Chemical and Petrochemical Industry (CIQyP) with the support of the Ministry of Environment and Sustainable Development (MAyDS) and the Climate Action programme for the Chemical Industry (CAPCI) implemented by the GIZ organize two national dialog forums for promoting knowledge exchange and dialogue with focus on the challenges and opportunities for the chemical industry for tapping mitigations measures.

The first event will take place on 24th November 2021 and the second meeting will be on 10th December 2021.
